While we felt optimistic about the landscape of Mbembesi, we, unfortunately, found ourselves drilling a total of three times. We are excited to report that we now have a functioning borehole right on the Mbembesi Church of Christ church grounds. Find below the summarized details of the W4M 2022 ministry:

1. Surveys

To locate the position for the borehole, the team engaged a number of surveyors. The first one was Mr. Perkins, who pegged the first borehole where, unfortunately, the drilling company hit a dry hole. The services of local surveyors were then employed, and they determined the best location to be where the current borehole stands.

2. Drilling

The first drilling was, unfortunately, a dry hole. Another borehole had to be drilled by the Imguza Drilling Company.

3. Borehole Installation

Mr. Ncube installed the borehole in early November.

4. Official Opening

The official opening of the borehole to the public was done on the 5th of November, 2022. Community leaders and members were present at the official opening of the borehole and were very excited that the church had provided a solution to their water problems. The community members were encouraged and inspired by the work of the Lord that the church is doing at Mbembesi. They showed so much gratitude and appreciation to the Mbembesi church of Christ and the Zimbabwe Missions Team.

5. Future Plans

In the future, the borehole will help the church have access to clean water that will sustain church programs such as Meals for Children. With potable water, the church members will engage in farming activities that will enable them to grow their own food. Moreover, the eventual preacher will be able to evangelize to the members of the community who will be coming to fetch water in the church.
