We are very optimistic about the growth of the church at Sipaba both in number and, more importantly, spiritually. ## **COVID-19 Update**

God has always been with His people, and we know without a shadow of a doubt that He will see us through this period of the coronavirus. We continue to pray for all those affected by the virus throughout the world. Here in Zimbabwe, as of end of March, we know of 7 cases that have been confirmed in the country and 1 death. We are very grateful that the government has taken various measures to keep the virus from spreading. Some of the measures taken include closing borders, limiting gatherings to 50, closing schools, encouraging people to practice good hygiene, to stay at home, and others. We continue to be extra careful ourselves as well in our day to day lives.

The Glovers are still in the USA because of the travel restrictions caused by the virus. They would love to be in Zimbabwe working, but they also have to be careful in traveling. Currently they are temporarily grounded in the USA and they will resume their travel once it's prudent to do so. As a result of COVID-19 here are some of the measures we have taken to play our part in this fight:

- Praying We have stayed prayerful, especially on all our Sunday services.
- *Closing Offices* We closed our offices temporarily until further notice, and we are currently working from home and abroad.
- Pausing Meals 4 Children We will be suspending our upcoming feedings until further notice.
- Sunday Service As of the end of March 30th our Sunday services were suspended until April 26 due to the 21-day nation lockdown. However, members have been left with all materials to conduct home services on missed Sundays.
- *Upholding Government Guidelines* As noted, the government has been giving us guidelines and we will continue to work within those directives

We know that times like these can be difficult, but even in times like these our Father wants us to go to Him. He cares for all of us, and we know He is always there for us. We leave you with the words of Peter, and we pray that these words will encourage us all in this time of distress.
