Many of the preachers especially those who are in rural Africa do not have any means of transportation other than walking on foot from one place to the next. Several of them walk miles not only for their personal business, but more importantly for their ministerial duties. We have so much respect for these fellow

workers of the Lord who minister under such conditions. The Wheels4Ministers (W4M) program is meant to benefit these types of

preachers who are crucial in spreading the gospel in the rural areas. Our hope is that every year 10 beneficiaries will each receive a bicycle to assist them with their local mission work.

Before receiving the bicycles, all beneficiaries will be expected to attend a W4M seminar where we study the Bible Basis for Missions.



Some of the topics we covered this year include Paul's Missionary Journeys and Principles, Misconceptions in Missions, and Missionary Strategies and Methodologies. These classes are meant to revitalize the missionary in all of the preachers, and the seminar provides a space for preachers to discuss and share Biblical insights of best sharing the good news in rural Zimbabwe. This year each preacher walked away from the seminar with a Bible, a bicycle, and a seminar booklet. Thank you for all the support that projects like these possible. We are already excited for next year's program!

The First Lessons4Couples Marriage Seminar at the Sipaba Church of Christ

We have always maintained that one of the characteristics of a strong church family is that of strong Biblical marriages. The Lessons4Couples (L4C) marriage seminar is geared towards helping and teaching couples about what a Biblical marriage looks like. We intend on having three L4C marriage seminars at all the church plants that we are a part of. The first seminar is primarily foundational in nature, and it deals with the Biblical basis for marriage. The second seminar deals with Marriage and Family Relationships, while the last seminar focuses on Communication and Sex. We are very excited about these seminars, and are prayerful that they will strengthen many marriages at Sipaba Church of Christ.

The first L4C at Sipaba was a success with over 50 individuals in attendance! Though it was a hot day, we managed to have a great time. The day had three sessions; two combined sessions, and a separate men and women's session. One of the ladies in attendance expressed gratitude being corrected and taught on what the scriptures have to say about a Biblical marriage.
