Bibles For Binga, Zimbabwe

The Scriptures For Souls ministry is expanding across southern Zimbabwe. On the 9th of October 2020 we were hosted by the Masikili Church of Christ in Binga, Zimbabwe where four congregations were gathered, namely Masikili, Manjolo, Siabuwa, and Lubu. We were able to distribute 60 Bibles to the Binga Brethren there, and this effort marked an addition of a third native language to the S4S ministry. The people in Binga primarily speak the Tonga language and had been in desperate need of Bibles written in their own mother tongue. The brethren were very grateful to be included in the ministry, and urged us to come back again. There is still a great need, and the efforts being extend in Binga are only helping to strengthen the Lord's church. Please keep the church in the Binga region in your prayers.

The Sipaba church of Christ is also doing well considering all that has transpired in 2020. Br. Sithole has finally been able to begin his biblical studies at Bear Valley Bible Institute - Zimbabwe. The church also hosted its first Youth Day Event with participants coming from various congregations. Three coordinators were chosen to run the feeding program and three men were chosen to assist with secretarial and treasury duties of the church. We are so thankful to see members stepping up to help with the Lord's work at Sipaba.

We cannot wait to see what God has in store for the year 2021. Thank you for your partnership thus far, and we pray we may continue working together in the year 2021 and beyond.

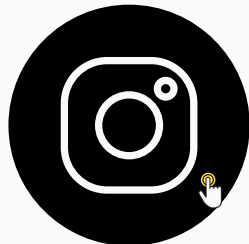
