On the 9th of October 2020 we were hosted by the Masikili Church of Christ in Binga, Zimbabwe where four congregations were gathered, namely Masikili, Manjolo, Siabuwa, and Lubu. We were able to distribute 60 Bibles to the Binga Brethren there, and this effort marked an addition of a third native language to the S4S ministry. The people in Binga primarily speak the Tonga language and had been in desperate need of Bibles written in their own mother tongue. The brethren were very grateful to be included in the ministry, and urged us to come back again. There is still a great need, and the efforts being extend in Binga are only helping to strengthen the Lord's church. Please keep the church in the Binga region in your prayers.
