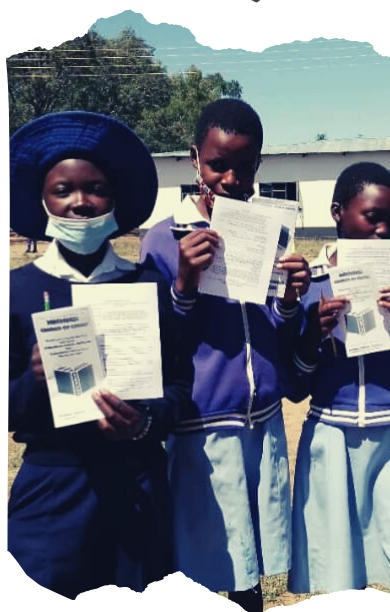


## Connecting the Community With Jesus

Recently we had the opportunity to work with the Cameroon Primary School located in the Mbembesi village where our new plant is based. The school leadership was very welcoming and allowed our team to address their pupils.



👉 On the day we went to the school, there were over 500 students present. We distributed pencils, crayons and coloring pages. More importantly, we had the opportunity to teach them a Bible lesson and invite them to both the church and to our church feeding ministry. The school staff and administration was grateful for our efforts. As a result of our visit, we saw our feeding program attendance at Mbembesi church of Christ almost double. Encouragement efforts such as these allow us to connect the community with Christ.

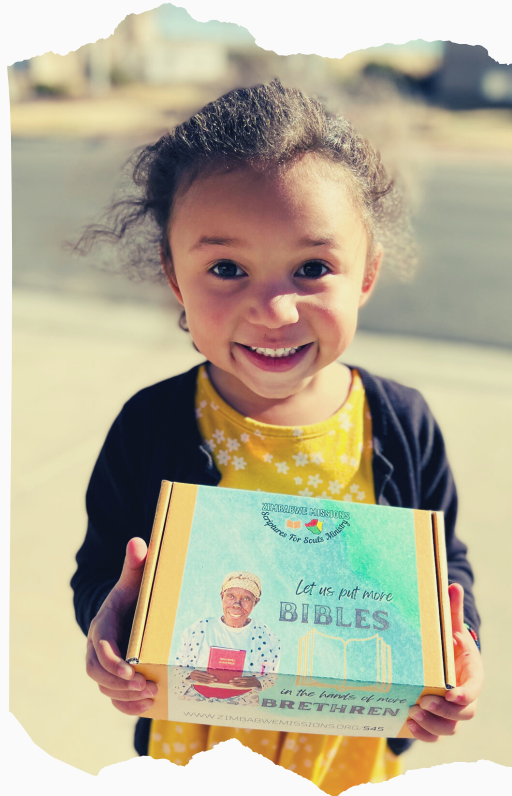

Besides fundraising, they will also be reporting to the current supporting congregations. In addition, Nkosi is going to serve as a Pulpit Minister Intern at Southwest Church of Christ - the overseeing congregation for Zimbabwe Missions.



# The "Bibles For Brethren Box" Project



Of all the ministries we do, none compares and connects with our brethren in the USA like the Scriptures For Souls project. This connection is a testimony of their love for the scripture and desire to see others around the globe have access to the same Word of God in their native tongue. Because we know how much people appreciate S4S and how they want to be involved with it, we are excited to tell you about our new Bible fundraiser project called "The Bibles For Brethren Box."

The fundraiser is aimed at ensuring the continuity of this ministry of arming believers with the word of God. Congregations would have the option to fundraise for 50 or more Bibles. The Bibles For Brethren Boxes (pictured above) would be sent to congregations willing to fundraise for Bibles, and each one would come with postcards for stateside members to leave words and verses of encouragement for the Bible recipients in Zimbabwe. This fundraiser could be a great service project for small groups, youth groups, or the whole congregation.

Projects like these reminds us of the connection we all have through the blood of Jesus. We all need to grow in the knowledge of our Lord by examining the scriptures. We now have a total of 11 students enrolled at ASBM. We are looking forward to this class graduating early next year with their accredited certificates in biblical studies. The next enrollment session for the class of 2023 will take place later this year.



## More Bibles Distributed

This year, over ten congregations have benefited from the Scriptures For Souls ministry. As you might already know, our target every year is 500 Bibles for the brethren who do not have access to God's Word. Our focus is mainly on the congregations in rural areas, though not limited to them only. We thank the Lord that we have managed to distribute 220 in total. We have several other congregations lined up already for the rest of the year. With the introduction of the Bibles For Brethren Box project, we are praying and hoping our target of 500 Bibles a year will increase, maybe to even 1,000 Bibles a year! We are asking that we all keep this ministry in prayer so many will grow in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior.

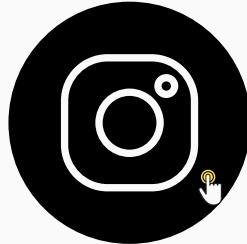
