

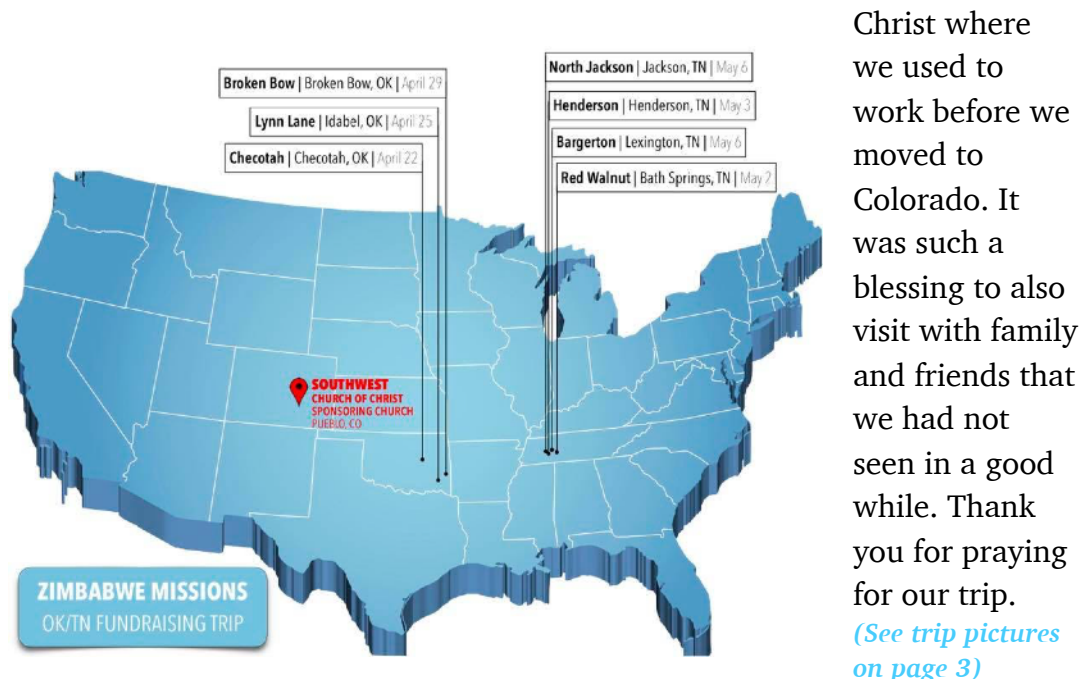
ZIMBABWE MISSIONS

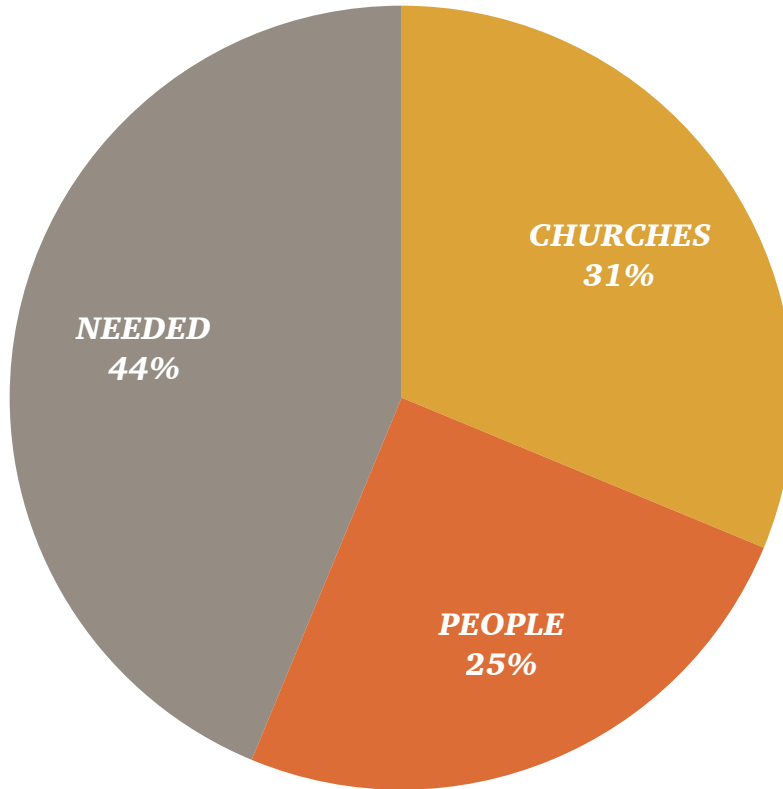

On June 25th we took a quick trip to New Mexico to be at the Red River Family Encampment in Red River, NM. We were given an opportunity to share Zimbabwe Missions on Tuesday to a crowd of over 1,000 people that morning. PROGRESS ON THE GROUND

Construction at the Amazon Christian Academy (ACA) keeps progressing forward. Recently we got in touch with Dorian Flynn who gave an update on the construction on the school property. As of right now, the



house of the caretaker of the school (pictured here) has been now completed. In fact, they have already moved in. The foundation of our house has also been completed, and we could not be more excited. What is even more exciting is that as of now they are building a temporary shelter, a pavilion of some sort, for the church we are going to be planting on the school grounds. As soon as we get



to Zimbabwe we can hit the ground running and begin establishing a congregation in the Filabusi region. Once again, construction at the ACA is continually progressing. Please continue to pray for Mr. Flynn as he continues to raise funds for the construction of the ACA.
