We are beyond blessed to be working alongside several great Christians in Zimbabwe. We are especially thankful for



the Ncube family. They are God fearing individuals who are also eager to share Jesus with everyone. Progress and Martha (the couple in the middle in the picture above) are Zimbabwe natives who grew up in the same town Nkosi grew up in - Bulawayo. They have two children a girl - Nolwazi - and a boy - Alwande.

At the moment he is a high school teacher while Martha is a stay at home mother. They are both pursing degrees from Zimbabwe Open University in preparation for the Amazon Christian Academy.
